NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRIES TAKEN ON SHOW DAY

ENTRY FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED FOR ENTRY INTO RINGS.

WAVIER MUST BE COMPLETED & SIGNED PRIOR TO LODGING ENTRIES.

NO MEASURING STEWARD WILL BE ATTENDING. YOU MUST HAVE YOUR REGISTERED HEIGHT CERTIFICATE WITH YOU WHILST COMPETING AT OUR SHOW

‘HORSE SECTION – Regulations *All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows which can be viewed at www.agshowsnsw.org.au. Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW shows.

‘INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS: The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Queanbeyan Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor’s property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. ALSO, on each Waiver, each horse with which the competitor is involved in competition at the Show must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.’ Agricultural Societies of NSW (ASC)

The committee reserves the right to alter or in fact delete events without prior notice. The committee accepts no responsibility for events clashing.

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for you

All Horse Exhibitors must enter via the Cooma Street Gates.

- Exhibitors will be charged a \$20 camping fee for Friday night.
- All exhibitors must pay to get in the gate. No refunds will be given.
- Horse entries will be taken on show day.
- Sporting entries close one hour prior to the event.
- No entry money refunded.
- Ribbons awarded to 3rd place. Prize Money or vouchers where stated.
- **Champion** - First prize winners only eligible. Reserve Champions will be selected from remaining first prize winners and the second prize winner that supplied the champion.
- Two calls only will be made to the marshalling yard, a warning call and then a final call. Late competitors will only be allowed to enter the ring at the Marshalling Steward's discretion.
- No person or persons under the influence of alcohol will be permitted to exhibit, handle or be in control of a horse or horses whilst in the ring.
- All exhibitors **MUST** wear appropriate headgear and attire whilst mounted on a horse and/or competing.
- Outside assistance to Competitors by word, by radio or any other method in Horse Ring Events will **NOT** be permitted. If in breach of this ruling, Competitors and their exhibits may be dismissed from the event and from the Showground. Competitor's names will be submitted to the ASC.
- Exhibitors must complete an entry form or their entries will not be accepted.
- Those competitors contemplating the use of electric fences to create portable yards, **BE WARNED**, their use may be appropriate prior to and following the show but will not be accepted during the course of the show. During such times it would be appreciated if these fences could be removed and trucks relocated to allow more room for other competitors.
- Any exhibitor who desires to enter a protest against any decision, act or omission on the part of the society, or any official of the society shall lodge a protest in writing within one hour on the day upon which the decision, act or omission occurred. The protest shall set out in detail the circumstances relied upon by such exhibitor, and shall be given to the Ring Secretary, accompanied by a fee of \$100, which shall be forfeited to the society should the protest be deemed frivolous.
- Stallions must be led & ridden by persons over 17 years or over.
- Stallions are not eligible to compete in any classes other than those specified.
- Unregistered horses will not be permitted to enter registered classes
- The judge's decision is final.
- The stewards will not tolerate bad language, and offending competitors will be subject to disqualification and forfeiture of any Prize Money.
Competitors ride at their own risk.
- No exhibitor shall at any time approach the judge
- All juvenile exhibitors in ring events when making entries must supply a declaration from parents or guardians as to age, if necessary. Age calculated at first day of show
- Drug testing of horses may be carried out at the Queanbeyan Show. Any competitor to have found to have breached the ASC disputes & disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee.
- Show Hunter classes are not eligible to enter hack classes.
- Hacks are not eligible to compete in Hunter Classes.

- Junior is considered 12yrs and under
- Horses may only compete in 3 classes
- If time allows and there is rider demand, we may go higher
- Led riders are eligible for jumping

Open cross rails- perfect time A2

Junior 45cm- perfect time A2
